In the published policy as part of developing a selection strategy, the International Panel pledged to identify the dates and venue(s) for 2019 selection. In order to meet organisation timelines for the 2019 Junior & U23 World Championships which will take place 1-5 May 2019 in Brazil, Junior & U23 selection is proposed to run together during March 2019 which is a change from the information published in the 2018 selection policy.

At present the weekends of 23/24 March 2019 and 30/31 March 2019 have been identified to host junior and U23 selection.

Senior Team selection is proposed to take place over 4 days on the 19-22 April at Lee Valley Whitewater Centre.
