Great Britain Junior & U23 Team Selection – Important Information:

In the published 2018 Canoe Sprint selection policy, there are requirements for athletes to produce a minimum performance standard at identified International races for selection to subsequent international races.

The International Panel accepts that the wording in the policy could be clearer on exactly how the performance standards are measured. For the forthcoming Junior & U23 World Championship Team selection, the Panel wish to be clear that the performance percentages will only be measured from athlete/crew performances in A, B or C finals at the Junior/U23 European Championships where the proximity of racing is such that it allows a direct level of comparison.
