*Important Information – Senior European Championships 2018

On Page 6 of the 2018 selection policy, the policy provides the right to send the strongest team to the Senior European Championships in Olympic events. Now that confirmation has been received that the European Games in 2019 will form a part of the Olympic Qualification process for Tokyo in Canoe events, the International Panel will be sending the top boat from the World Cup series to the European Championships in 2018 in the canoe events.

ECA Paracanoe European Championships, Belgrade, 8-10 June 2018

Following a recent ICF reclassification event, Dave Philipson who is already selected in the VL3 event has been provisionally reclassified into the KL2 Category. In line with page 12 of the published Junior World Championship Team selection policy regarding the clash between the Marathon Junior European Champs and the July regatta, a request has been received and accepted by the IP that in the WK2 500m, the winners of the July regatta subject to achieving the published standard, would be required to participate in a single race off in the w/c 9th July against Freya Peters/Emma Russell for a place at the Junior World Championships.
