Olympic Selection Appeals – Important Information ahead of announcement of nominations

There is a full right of appeal but due to the tight timing between the announcement of the nominations on Monday 30th September and the date of travel to the Olympic Test Event, there will be a modified timeline in place which has been determined by the British Canoeing Head of Governance. The British Canoeing 2019 Canoe Slalom Senior 2020 Olympic Selection Policy will apply with the following modifications to Appendix 1:

1. STAGE 1: REVIEW

1.1/1.2 A written request for formal review must be submitted by <u>09.00am on Tuesday 1st October</u> to the Head of Governance <u>Nancy.squires@britishcanoeing.org.uk</u>. This will be reviewed by the International Panel in consultation with Programme leads.

1.3 The International Panel will advise in writing the outcome of the review and the decision reached by 2.00pm on Wednesday 2nd October.

2. STAGE 2: APPEAL

2. If, following the formal review, the Athlete wishes to formally appeal the decision, then a written Notice of Appeal must be submitted by them to British Canoeing Head of Governance by <u>9.00am on Friday 4th October 2019</u>.

The appeal panel will aim to confirm its decision in writing to the Athlete by 5.00pm on Monday 7th October. If, due to the number of appeals received or the complexity of a particular appeal, this timeframe cannot be met, the Athlete will be informed as soon as possible. The latest date an Athlete will be advised of the outcome of their appeal is Wednesday 9th October.

An appeal panel and reserve panel have been appointed to hear any selection appeals. Immediately following the publication of the selection nominations on Monday 29th September, all athletes from the World Championships will be supplied the names of the panel members and Athletes will be asked to ensure that if they have objections to **any** of the six named panel members hearing their appeal, that they state this objection (with reasons for the objection) in their notice of appeal.
