

## **Clear Access Clear Water Champion 2019**

### **Terms and Conditions**

**Entrants will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions, and agreed to be bound by them, when entering this monthly competition.**

#### **Prize:**

1. The winner of this competition will receive:
  - 1.1. 1 x PEAK Clear Access Clear Waters Buoyancy Aid.
2. In addition, the winner will be given the chance to write a blog on the British Canoeing Website which will be shared across social media channels (proof to be approved by the Communications Team, support available).
3. As part of this competition a number of spot prizes may also be awarded to entrants:
  - 3.1. A Clear Access Clear Waters boat or car sticker.
4. The prizes as described above are available on the date of publication of these terms but British Canoeing reserves the right to change the prizes on offer without notice.
5. The prizes are non-transferable. No cash alternative can be claimed.
6. Prizes must be claimed by the end of the month of the offer. After this date, claims will no longer be valid.
7. The delivery of the prizes (if applicable) will be arranged once the winners have been contacted.

#### **Who may enter:**

8. This competition is open to residents of England, except for employees of British Canoeing or PEAK UK.
9. With the exception of British Canoeing and PEAK UK employees, all nominations submitted through the British Canoeing Online form will be entered into the Spot Prize Draw.
10. Entry to the competition is free and no purchase is necessary.
11. Entries are limited to one entry per email address.

#### **How to enter:**

12. Entrants should submit an entry via the online form on the British Canoeing website [https://britishcanoeing.formstack.com/forms/nomination\\_for\\_community\\_clear\\_access\\_clear\\_waters\\_champion](https://britishcanoeing.formstack.com/forms/nomination_for_community_clear_access_clear_waters_champion) by the last working day of each calendar month of submission.
13. Entrants should detail in their submission how they have made an inspirational impact on delivering the principles of the Clear Access Clear Waters Charter on access and environmental issues. This might be campaigning locally, negotiating better access for

paddlers, or going above and beyond to protect and preserve or enhance the environment.

**Winner selection and notification:**

14. The winner will be selected from the eligible entries based on the impact made on delivering the principles of the Clear Access Clear Waters Charter on access and environmental issues in the previous 12 months.
15. In order to consider the impact made in delivering the principles of the Clear Access Clear Waters Charter, the judges will consider the following four factors and score each out of five (five being the highest score available):
  - 15.1. How has the individual or group made a positive difference to local or regional access to water for paddlers? What action have they undertaken to enhance or protect access to water for future generations?
  - 15.2. What has the individual or group done to make a difference to the environment; is it cleaner, healthier? What action have they undertaken to enhance or protect the environment for future generations?
  - 15.3. Consider how the individual or group has raised awareness of environmental good practice such as Check, Clean, Dry?
  - 15.4. How has the individual or group inspired others to deliver the principles of Clear Access Clear Waters Campaign going above and beyond?
16. Following the process detailed in clause 15, the winner will be the entrant scoring the highest cumulative points total.
17. In the event of a tie, the judges will decide upon the winner by considering overall impact.
18. Winners of the spot prize detailed in clause 3.1 will be selected at random from the pool of eligible entrants.
19. Any decision regarding prize winners will be final, with no correspondence being entered into by British Canoeing or PEAK UK in respect of any decision made by the judges.
20. All winners will be selected by 15<sup>th</sup> of the month following submission and will be notified via the email they supplied when submitting their entry. Winners will be notified no later than 22<sup>nd</sup> of the month following submission.
21. In the event that the first winner chosen cannot be contacted within two weeks of 22<sup>nd</sup> of the respective month, a replacement winner will be selected based on the criteria detailed in clause 15 and will be subsequently contacted.

22. British Canoeing will not be held responsible if a winner cannot be contacted using the email address given.

### **Media and Communications**

23. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit as part of their entry have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws.
24. Copyright in all images and content submitted for this competition remains with the respective entrants. However, in consideration of their providing the Competition, each entrant grants a royalty free, worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to British Canoeing to feature any or all of the submitted images or content in any of their publications, their websites and/or in any promotional material connected to this competition and that of PEAK UK communications.
25. By entering into the competition you are agreeing to continue to champion the case for #ClearAccessClearWaters over the next 12 months.

### **Liability:**

26. Events may occur that render the competition itself or the awarding of the prizes impossible due to reasons beyond the control of British Canoeing and PEAK UK and accordingly British Canoeing and PEAK UK may at their absolute discretion vary or amend the promotion and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to British Canoeing and PEAK UK as a result thereof.
