

National Go Canoeing Week 2018 - Logging your miles

Terms and Conditions

Entrants will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions, and agreed to be bound by them, when entering this Competition.

Prize:

1. As part of this competition, a number of prizes will be awarded:
 - 1.1. The adult male and female achieving the highest mileage in their category will each receive a £100 Peak UK voucher.
 - 1.2. The junior male and female achieving the highest mileage in their category will each receive a Palm waterproof jacket and Go Canoeing drink bottle.
 - 1.3. The club achieving the highest total mileage will receive 3 x buoyancy aids and 3 x paddles from Palm Equipment.
 - 1.4. The organisation achieving the highest total mileage will receive 3 x bespoke National Go Canoeing Week buoyancy aids from Peak UK and 3 x Go Canoeing t-shirts.
 - 1.5. 10 mystery prize bundles provided by Cotswold Outdoor and British Canoeing will be awarded to 10 randomly chosen competition entrants.
2. The prizes as described above are available on the date of publication of these terms but British Canoeing reserves the right to change the prizes on offer without notice.
3. The prizes are non-transferable. No cash alternative can be claimed.
4. Prizes must be claimed by December 31st 2018. After this date, claims will no longer be valid.
5. The delivery of the prizes (if applicable) will be arranged once the winners have been contacted.

Who may enter:

6. This competition is open to residents of the UK, Channel Islands and Isle of Man, except for employees of British Canoeing.
7. With the exception of British Canoeing employees, everyone who logs miles through the website between the 26th May and 13th June 2018 will be entered into the Prize Draw.
8. Only miles paddled between the 26th May and 3rd June 2018 are eligible for entry.
9. Entry to the competition is free and no purchase is necessary.
10. Entries are limited to one entry per email address.

Winner selection and notification:

11. In the event that more than one participant, club, or organisation share the highest total mileage logged, a winner will be selected at random from these entrants. The decision will be final, with no correspondence being entered into by British Canoeing in respect of any decision made by the judge.
12. For the random prize draw, winners will be picked entirely at random from the pool of eligible participants entering the competition. The decision will be final, with no correspondence being entered into by British Canoeing in respect of any decision made by the judge.
13. All winners will be selected by the 22nd June and will be notified via the email they supplied when logging their miles. Winners will be notified no later than 29th June 2017.
14. In the event that the first winner drawn cannot be contacted within two weeks of 29nd June, the next eligible entrant will be contacted.
15. British Canoeing will not be held responsible if a winner cannot be contacted using the email address given.

Liability:

16. Events may occur that render the competition itself or the awarding of the prizes impossible due to reasons beyond the control of British Canoeing and accordingly British Canoeing may at its absolute discretion vary or amend the promotion and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to British Canoeing as a result thereof.
17. All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the competitor agrees to abide by these terms and conditions. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
