

RECALL NOTICE

British Canoeing has been made aware of a product recall for a lifejacket presenting a serious risk of drowning.

The model being recalled is a Lifejacket 150N sold via Amazon. Please note that this is a lifejacket and not a buoyancy aid.

The product does not meet the requirements of the PPE Regulation 2016/425.

The product is classed as Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). The product was not supplied with the required compliance documentation or markings to demonstrate that it had been adequately conformity assessed.
