

RECALL NOTICE

11th August 2022

British Canoeing has been made aware of a product recall for Stand Up Paddleboards presenting a risk of exposure to water/drowning.

The models being recalled are for Jobe Duna 11.6 and Jobe Yarra Teal 10.6 Inflatable Paddle Board Package, identified as presenting a risk of drowning due to a faulty glue which creates leakage through the seams of the board, causing the paddleboard to deflate.

The products have been identified as presenting a risk of exposure to water / drowning as its substandard glue should have a minimal life cycle of 5 years when used normally and maintained properly, however research has shown that this is not the case for the defaulted batch. The substandard glue creates leakage through the seams of the board and if the seam separates when the product is in use, the user may fall into the water unexpectedly.
